These large-scale events bring a significant financial impact to their host cities, and shine light and wealth on fantastic charities and nonprofits benefitting the LGBTQIA+ community. Hartsfield-Jackson International is the busiest airport in the world.



GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Taking on the role of captain is an enjoyable way to engage and contribute!

As a captain, you'll be responsible for organizing your team, ensuring everyone is informed about schedules and locations, such as the proximity of venues to the host hotel or the convenience of public transportation options like MARTA. 7 DAYS OUT

Confirm Your Roster and Team Waivers

- Ensure that your roster and team waivers are finalized.
- Distribute the schedule to your teammates, making sure everyone understands the expectations for the weekend.
- Take a moment to review the rules with your team members.

48 HOURS OUT

Confirm Your Attendance and Travel Arrangements

- Verify your attendance and finalize your travel plans.
- Appoint your co-captain for the event.
- Review the weather plan provided by the tournament team.

24 HOURS OUT

Check in at the Starling Hotel for registration. Be sure to share meeting locations with your teammates for the Saturday games.

Kickball will play round-robin style on Saturday, with an elimination style tournament on Sunday to determine the winners of each division.

KICKBALL RULES

Below the Belt follows the traditional kickball set of rules with 11 players in the field, 5 innings, and games that won't exceed 60 minutes.

GETTING AROUND ATLANTA

GENERAL TRANSIT

MARTA is a quick and easy way to get around Atlanta. Breeze cards make getting on and off the train simple. Load your card with as many trips or days as you'd like. A single trip costs only \$2.50. We've noted the Midtown stop on the map closest to the host hotel.

Below the Belt Sports is lucky enough to have venues that are walking distance from the host hotel. For our event venues, we suggest rideshares such as Lyft. Parking is limited at the events.

WALKABILITY

Kickball venues are right down the street from the host hotel! Take a quick scoot down 14th street straight to the entrance of Piedmont Park and the active oval.
